Forecast for Thursday 03 Jun 2021

Weather: Showers dying out during the morning and gradually brightening up. Then mostly dry with with sunny spells developing.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 40% improving 80% during the afternoon.

Visibility: Misty conditions at first but visibility becoming good beneath the clouds during the morning. Extensive cloud cover about 600 to 700m with patches lower down at first, breaking up in the afternoon.

Forecast for Friday 04 Jun 2021

Weather: It will be a dry, bright day with sunny spells.

Maximum wind: Freshening southerly winds with average speeds of 10mph increasing 20mph and gusts 35mph on the tops in the afternoon.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%

Visibility: Very good with occasional cloud cover building mostly above the tops. Some patches forming around 700m.

Temperature: **Valleys:** 10 Celsius rising to 20 Celsius.

At 800m: 9 Celsius.

Freezing level: Well above the summits.
