Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Monday 03 June to 0600 UTC Tuesday 04 June 2019

General Situation

A large area of low pressure to the northwest of the British Isles will dominate the United Kingdom during today, before another area of low pressure moves across the United Kingdom during Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing east or southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South backing east or southeast for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, backing east or southeast 5 or 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Mainly fair, then rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, backing southerly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Mainly fair, then thundery rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far east, backing southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwesterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, then thundery rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, veering southwest 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Rain or showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west or northwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, backing south or southeast later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, veering southwest, then veering northwest later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing south or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far south.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then west or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later, then backing southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then west 5 or 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, backing southeast later, 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, becoming slight later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast, backing northeast, then backing west or northwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Occasional rain, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.

Showers, occasionally rain later in south.

Good, occasionally poor later in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 3 or 4, then cyclonic 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 or 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first in North Channel, becoming mainly slight later.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly becoming variable 3 or 4, then cyclonic 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in northwest.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, 3 or 4, becoming north 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering westerly 5 or 6, then decreasing 3 or 4 later in south.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough at times in south and far north.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, then occasionally 7 later in south.

Slight or moderate, but mainly rough in far north and at times in far south.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering westerly 5 or 6, then decreasing 3 or 4 later in south.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in south.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, then occasionally 7 later in south.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will pass to the west of Shetland over the next 24 hours.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:

Southwesterly gale force 8 expected soon. Issued 21:44 UTC on Sunday 2 June 2019

South or southwest 5 or 6

Moderate or rough

Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 03 Jun until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7 occasionally gale 8 in west

Moderate or rough

Occasional rain or showers

Moderate or good, occasionally poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 3 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 in the south of the area by midday, becoming mainly southerly 2 to 4 by evening.

Slight, decreasing smooth in the south by midday.

Isolated showers.

Good, perhaps locally moderate by dawn on Tuesday.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 3 to 4, soon increasing 4 to 5, veering south to southwest in the afternoon, then southwest to west early evening, decreasing 2 to 4 later.

Slight, locally smooth in the south, generally increasing slight to moderate in the evening, with a low swell.

Showers or longer spells of rain, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, clearing by evening risk of showers after midnight.

Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps poor.

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
