#### General Situation

A large area of high pressure will remain centred to the west of the United Kingdom with a ridge extending eastwards across Denmark.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 in shelter.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Westerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in east.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers mainly in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

North 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 at times in shelter.

Slight in shelter otherwise moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering northeast 5 to 7.

Remaining smooth or slight in shelter, otherwise becoming moderate or rough.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times in shelter.

Slight in shelter otherwise moderate.

Showers near Isles of Scilly.

North veering northeast 5 to 7, but mainly 4 or 5 at first, and increasing gale 8 at times near headlands.

Slight in shelter otherwise moderate or rough.

Northerly or northeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Slight in east and in shelter, otherwise moderate.

Showers in far west.

North 4 or 5 veering northeast 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in west.

Showers mainly in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near western headlands.

Mainly slight.

Showers later.

Mainly good.

Northerly veering northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near western headlands.

Slight or moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

North 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

North, backing northwest for a time, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers for a time later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

#### Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A ridge of high pressure weakens as frontal troughs move east over Shetland today. The moderate, occasionally fresh, westerly flow continues.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

Northeast to north 5 to 6.  
Slight in the southeast, moderate occasionally rather rough in the north and west.  
Isolated wintry showers mainly in the south.  
Good, moderate to poor in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly 5 to 6, occasionally 7 with gusts to 45kt, increasing 7 to gale 8 Friday morning.  
Moderate to rather rough, increasing rough in the north and west by Thursday evening.  
Scattered wintry showers, becoming isolated Friday morning.  
Good, moderate to poor in showers.

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
