General Situation

A ridge of high pressure remains dominant over much of the United Kingdom during the next couple of days. An Atlantic front will approach northwest Scotland on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.

Fog patches in east, rain later in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure over the Northern North Sea will gradually decline, allowing a cold front to approach from the northwest on Tuesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming cyclonic 2 or 3 in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate until later in west.

Fog patches

Good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 01 Jun until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jun:

Southerly 3 or 4 at first in east, otherwise cyclonic 2 or 3, becoming

northeasterly 4 or 5 in northwest later.
Slight, becoming smooth east of Shetland.
Fog patches. Rain in northwest later.
Good, occasionally very poor.
