### Forecast for Thursday 08 Jul 2021

**Weather:** Low cloud near the west coast throughout the day. Sunny spells in the east at first, but cloud building here through the day. Low cloud spreads inland across the far north from mid-afternoon, then becoming widespread through the evening bring patchy drizzle.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 20% in west, 70% in southeast. Falling to 10% across all ranges through the evening.

**Visibility:** Generally good, but poor where low cloud affects western hills, cloud bases around 400-500m, rising to around 700-800m in the afternoon. Widespread cloud lowering to 600-700m late evening.

**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

Cloud detail rather uncertain.

**Forecast for Friday 09 Jul 2021**

**Weather:** Mainly cloudy with some hill fog and the odd patch of drizzle. Perhaps turning brighter in the south late in the day

**Maximum wind:** Variable 5-10mph.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 20%, rising 50% in south later.

**Visibility:** Occasionally moderate or poor in drizzle, and very poor in cloud widely down to 450-750m.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 13 Celsius at dawn rising to Plus 17 in the afternoon, perhaps 19 or 20 if it brightens in the south.

**At 800m:** Plus 11 Celsius.

**Freezing level:** Above the summits.
