#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will only drift very slowly southeastwards, and will maintain very unsettled and in places windy conditions throughout this forecast period.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Rough or very rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East backing northeast 5 to 7.

Moderate at times in shelter, otherwise rough or very rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Mainly good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, mainly east or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate at times in south, otherwise rough or very rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East backing northeast 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 5 or 6, becoming southeast 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast backing east 4 or 5, then northeast 6 or 7.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate and smooth at times in shelter.  
Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, mainly southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate for a time.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in east, decreasing 3 to 5, then increasing 6 west 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near headlands and in west.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly, veering northerly later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far west.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough, mainly in southwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly veering northerly later, 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 for

a time, except in southwest.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.  
Occasional rain or thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic, becoming northwest for a time, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.  
Moderate or rough in south, slight or moderate in north.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming north or northwest 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.  
Occasional rain or thundery showers.  
Good occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
North or northwest becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.  
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming north or northwest 5 to 7.  
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in west.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast 3 or less, backing northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time, then variable 3 or less later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming northeast 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers, occasional rain later.  
Good occasionally moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 3 or 4, becoming northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.  
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly backing northerly later, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first.  
Smooth at first in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 or 4, becoming northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.  
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly backing northerly later, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first.  
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in North Channel.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in north.  
Slight or moderate in southeast, moderate or rough in northwest.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Mainly good.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far north.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far north.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Mainly good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far north.  
Rough or very rough.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.  
Rough or very rough.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Low pressure persists across the southern North Sea and Central British Isles  
maintaining a strong northeasterly airstream across Shetland Waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Gale force 8

backing northeasterly imminent. Issued at 15:49 UTC on Saturday 02 November 2019.

Northeasterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later in far southeast.  
Very rough, but rough southwest of Shetland.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 03 Nov until 0000 UTC on Monday 04 Nov:  
Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 in southeast.  
Rough or very rough.  
Fair.  
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 to 6, locally variable 1 to 4, backing north to northwest by dawn, then westerly 5 to 7 during the morning, increasing 7 to gale 8 for a time during the afternoon with gusts to 50kt, backing southwest 4 to 6 during the evening.

Moderate to rather rough, increasing rough to very rough by midday, decreasing rather rough to rough by midnight.

Occasional showers or longer periods of rain, locally heavy with the risk of thunder.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 6, occasionally 7 until afternoon.

Rather rough to rough, with moderate swell.

Occasional showers or longer periods of rain, locally heavy with the risk of thunder.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
