#### General Situation

The slack pressure pattern will persist, bringing reasonably light winds to most places.

across Shetland waters.

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east  
Rough at first in east, otherwise moderate but slight in well sheltered western  
waters

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in east

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 4 to 5, decreasing 2 to 4 overnight, occasionally 5 jersey southwards.

Slight to moderate.

Mist patches isolated showers.

Moderate to good, locally poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 to 4, locally 5 jersey southwards at first, backing north in the evening, decreasing 1 to 3 by dawn, locally variable.

Slight with a low swell.

Scattered showers, with a risk of thunder mist patches.

Moderate to good, locally poor at times.

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
