Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 03 November to 1200 UTC Monday 04 November 2019

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will remain over the British Isles and surrounding waters during Sunday and Monday, then will drift southeast over the Continent on Tuesday, maintaining unsettled conditions across the coastal waters.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 5 to 7.

Rough, occasionally very rough in southeast.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Moderate at times in shelter, otherwise rough, occasionally very rough at first in southeast.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 to 6, backing northeast 6 or 7.

Moderate at times in south, otherwise rough or very rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 near Berwick upon Tweed, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, backing northeasterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later in north.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north, but 3 or 4 at first in south.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, backing east later, 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 2 or 3, backing northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, backing southerly 3 to 5, becoming variable 4 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 or less, becoming northerly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, veering westerly 5 or 6, backing southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing west 5 or 6, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, then moderate later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5, then north 4 to 6.

Moderate, occasionally rough in south, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in west, backing westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later in west.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter and very rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in west, then northerly 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter and very rough in southwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in southwest, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 5 to 7, becoming northerly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in west.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest and later in northwest.
Showers.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6, then variable 4 or less, becoming northeast 3 to 5 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in northeast and rough at first in southwest.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast 3 to 5, backing north 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.
Showers.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 4 or less, then east or northeast 4 to 6.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in northwest.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first near Mull of Galloway, backing north later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in southeast and rough later in southwest.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 4 or less, then northeast 5 or 6 later.
Slight becoming moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming northeast 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, but smooth or slight at first in south.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast 5 to 7, backing north 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 to 5, veering northeasterly 5 or 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northerly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time, occasionally smooth later in Firth of Clyde.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 or 7, backing north 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in southeast.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5, veering northeast 3 or 4, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate except in north.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north 5.

Rough or very rough in northwest, moderate or rough in southeast.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5, veering northeast 3 or 4, then southeast 4 or 5 later.

Rough, occasionally very rough at first in northwest, and moderate later in southeast.

Showers.

Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Complex slow moving low across UK maintaining a brisk easterly flow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Gale force 8 backing northeasterly imminent. Issued at 15:49 UTC on Saturday 02 November 2019.

Easterly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 in southeast
Rough or very rough
Fair

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 04 Nov until 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Nov:

Easterly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first in southeast
Rough or very rough
Fair
Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 5 to 7, locally gale 8 this afternoon, backing southwest 5 to 6 in the evening, occasionally 7, veering westerly for a time overnight.
Rather rough to rough, increasing rough to very rough this afternoon, decreasing rather rough to rough by midnight.
Occasional showers, becoming more frequent and locally heavy at times risk of thunder, mainly from Monday morning.
Good, occasionally moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 7, occasionally 8, mainly in the south of the area during the afternoon, veering northwest to north overnight.
Rather rough to rough, increasing rough to very rough during the afternoon until late evening, with a low to moderate swell.
Frequent showers, occasionally heavy with the risk of thunder.
Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
