Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Wednesday 04 August to 0000 UTC Thursday 05 August 2010

General Situation

A shallow area of low pressure is expected to run southeastwards across southern Ireland and then across south Wales and southwest England during Wednesday. A temporary ridge is expected to build across the United Kingdom on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time around Cape Wrath. Slight, but moderate north and west of Orkney, occasionally rough near Cape Wrath.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest, 4 or 5 decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight, but moderate north and west of Orkney, and occasionally rough at first north of Cape Wrath.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, but variable 3 or less for a time in north, occasionally 5 in south later.

Slight.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7, veering northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Rain or showers.

Northwesterly backing westerly 4 or 5.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Slight, becoming moderate.

West veering northwest, 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate but slight in Bristol Channel.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest backing southwest later, 4 or 5.
Moderate but slight in Bristol Channel.
Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly veering northwesterly, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 for a time in south.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming southwesterly 3 or 4 later.
Moderate.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

Slight occasionally moderate.

patches, clearing later in the afternoon.
Good, becoming moderate to very poor at times.
