Forecast for Thursday 01 Sep 2022

Weather: Any early mist and fog in the valleys will quickly clear, leaving a dry and bright morning. Cloud soon thickening, with only limited brighter or sunny spells during the afternoon. Staying dry into the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 70% increasing to 90% by midday.

Low cloud and visibility: Locally very poor visibility at low levels in any early mist and fog. This clearing through the morning, although may cover some slopes and summits as it does. Otherwise good visibility expected, although some distant hills appearing hazy.

Forecast for Friday 02 Sep 2022

Weather: A few showers across eastern hills during the early hours, before clearing and perhaps allowing a few mist and fog patches to develop. These quickly clearing through the morning. Staying rather cloudy, with showers spreading north through the afternoon, perhaps heavy at times. Some routes likely remaining dry, however.

Maximum wind: Easterly, 15-20mph, gusts up to 25mph. Becoming Southeasterly, 5-10mph by late afternoon.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: 80%

Low cloud and visibility: Locally poor visibility in any early mist and fog, briefly obscuring some slopes summits as it lifts through the morning. Cloud then mainly above summits, though some patchy cloud obscuring tops above 400m during any showers. Good visibility expected, though becoming moderate to poor in any heavy showers

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 13 Celsius rising to Plus 24 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 9 Celsius rising to Plus 15 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above all summits.
