Forecast for Monday 04 Jul 2022

Weather: Cloud building during the early hours, bringing the risk of an isolated light shower through the morning. Generally dry by late-morning as the cloud breaks up somewhat to allow intervals of strong sunlight throughout the afternoon and into the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 80% to begin, falling to 40% for mid-morning, and then rising to above 80% by for the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Broken cloud shrouding summits down to around 500-600m during the first half of the morning. This cloud then lifting to above the summits for late morning and the remainder of the day. Poor visibility at lower levels should any showers pass over in the morning, but largely very good from the afternoon with clear views of surrounding hills.

Meteorologist's View

Although cloudy in the morning, when sunny intervals develop for the afternoon UV levels will be high, so be sure to wear appropriate protection.

Forecast for Tuesday 05 Jul 2022

Weather: Clear skies to begin the day with a few mist and shallow fog patches possible in the valleys but clearing readily after dawn. Cloud builds into the morning, lowest in the west, with the low risk of some accompanying light rain and drizzle. Cloud breaking up from mid-afternoon, allowing for some clear spells into the evening.

Maximum wind: 15mph northwesterly winds on the summits.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90% or greater in the early hours, dropping to 40% in the west and 60% in the east during the middle of the day, and then rising to 80% everywhere in the evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Moderate visibility in any valley mist first thing. Cloud lowering during the morning, falling to 500-600m by late-morning, primarily in the west, and covering slopes above this through to mid-afternoon. Some clearer interludes developing later in the afternoon as cloud rises to above the summits. Visibility below cloud bases will largely be good but may turn moderate should any rain or drizzle occur.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 10 Celsius rising to plus 20 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 7 Celsius, rising to plus 11 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
