Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

Low pressure remains slow moving near northwestern Scotland, with showers or longer spells of rain affecting most areas.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in southeast at first, becoming variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers, with fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north at first, becoming variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers, with fog patches mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5, becoming variable 2 or 3 later in north.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, but mainly 4 or 5 in north.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Moderate or rough.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in east at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 for a time.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Moderate or rough.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Showers, with rain in south for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Moderate or rough.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Moderate or rough, decreasing slight in far north later.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming west or southwest 3 or 4.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Slight or moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southwesterly, 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south at first.

Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around Outer Hebrides.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate or rough.

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
