Forecast for Saturday 02 Sep 2023

Weather: Misty start with low cloud, the cloud lifting and breaking up through the morning then staying dry and mostly sunny in the afternoon and evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 40% becoming 95% through morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Some areas of low cloud to start the morning, mainly on low to mid-slopes. Otherwise, visibility will be good.

Meteorologist's View

Feeling warm in the afternoon in the valleys and on the ascents with highs of 20 or 21 Celsius.

Forecast for Sunday 03 Sep 2023

Weather: Dry overnight but some areas of mist or fog developing. These will burn off through the morning with another dry and mostly sunny day in the hills. Feeling warm at low levels but a cooling breeze at height.

Maximum wind: South or Southwest 15 to 20mph, gusts 25mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 60% becoming 95%.

Low cloud and visibility: Mainly good visibility. Patchy low cloud and fog at first, mainly in the west, but clearing through the morning.

Temperature: **Valleys:** 13C rising to 19 to 21C.

At 700m: 10C rising to 13C.

Freezing level: Above summits.
