#### General Situation

Frontal troughs will move eastwards across the United Kingdom as a very deep low becomes

established to the west of Ireland.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Southerly veering westerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, backing southerly 4 or 5 later.

Rough.

Moderate or poor becoming good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

South or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west for a time, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Rough or very rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or poor becoming good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high in west.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or poor becoming good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high in southwest.

Rain then squally showers.  
Moderate or poor becoming good.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Rough, occasionally very rough in south.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.  
Rain then squally showers.  
Moderate or poor becoming good.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly for a time, 5 to 7,  
occasionally gale 8 in north.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Moderate or rough.  
Rain then squally showers.  
Moderate or poor becoming good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 6 or 7, veering southwest 4 or 5 for a time, occasionally gale 8  
later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8  
in east.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in north.  
Rain at times.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly veering southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Rough in east, very rough, increasing high in north.  
Squally showers.  
Mainly good.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the  
North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8  
in east.  
Moderate or rough.

Rain at times.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Rough becoming very rough in north.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.  
Rough or very rough.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast veering southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9.  
Very rough or high.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.  
Very rough.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeasterly veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9.  
Very rough or high, perhaps very high later.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 4 increasing 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough south of skye.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast 5 to 7.  
Moderate north of skye rough or very rough south of skye.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Channel Islands - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 5 to 6, locally 7 at first, backing south 5 to 6 this afternoon,  
locally 4 in the south, increasing  
6 to 7 this evening.  
Moderate in south to rough in north.  
Scattered showers dying by mid-morning occasional rain and drizzle from early  
afternoon, becoming  
persistent after midnight and heavier later.  
Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South 6 to 7, very soon veering southwest 5 to 6, increasing 6 to 7 for a time  
late morning, decreasing 4  
to 5 by Sunday evening, backing south overnight.  
Moderate in south to rough in north, decreasing slight to moderate overnight.

Rain, locally heavy, clearing by mid-morning scattered showers by afternoon.  
Moderate to poor soon becoming mainly good.
