General Situation

Low pressure to the northwest of the United Kingdom today will bring a warm airflow to most parts, as well as strong winds, mainly in the north and west.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.
Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Moderate.

Rain or showers, occasionally thundery, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast veering south, 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, fog patches.

South veering southwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Showers, occasionally thundery.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight.

Occasional rain, then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering southwesterly later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Slight.

Mainly fair, fog patches later in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight.

Fog patches at first, showers for a time, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southeasterly, veering southwesterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west, but variable 3 at times in Bristol Channel.

Moderate, but slight in Bristol Channel.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.

Moderate.

Showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 at times in Cardigan Bay.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Moderate.

Showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Mull of Galloway, but variable 3 at times in Liverpool Bay.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.
Showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East, veering southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.
Slight.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast veering southwest, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East, veering southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.
Slight, becoming moderate or rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast veering southwest, 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Thursday 01 Aug 2013 at 0600 UTC until Thursday 01 Aug 2013 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Low centred west of the UK will push a warm front north over Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Variable 3 or less becoming east 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Thursday 01 Aug until 0600 UTC on Friday
02 Aug:
East 5 or 6 veering southeast 4 or 5.

Moderate.
Rain, fog patches later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor later.

Channel Islands
24 hour forecast:

Southeast to south 2 to 4, locally 5 in the south of the area, veering west to northwest 3 to 4 late afternoon, backing south overnight.

Slight.

Sea fog patches in the west of the area spreading eastwards during the afternoon and evening scattered showers overnight.

Moderate to good, occasionally very poor in sea fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3 in the afternoon, then southwest increasing 4 overnight.

Mainly slight with a low swell.

Scattered showers and sea fog patches, clearing by mid-afternoon.

Moderate to good, occasionally very poor in sea fog.
