Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 to 1200 UTC

General Situation

An area of high pressure will remain slow moving over the eastern Atlantic during Tuesday with a cool mainly north to northwesterly airflow across the British Isles.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable then southeast 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
