General Situation

Pressure will remain high near Iceland maintaining a fairly slack northerly or northeasterly airflow across the United Kingdom during the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Variable 3 or 4 at first in west, otherwise northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far east.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, except in sheltered west.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Variable, but with afternoon onshore sea breezes, 3 or 4.

General Situation
High north of Faeroes extends a ridge southeast over Shetland and surrounding waters.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to north 1 to 3, locally variable, backing northwesterly late morning, occasionally 4 in the east in the afternoon.

Smooth or slight.

Fair to cloudy risk of mist patches by Sunday morning.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 2 to 3, becoming variable by the evening then becoming northeasterly overnight, perhaps locally 4 by morning.

Smooth or slight with a low swell developing overnight.

Fair to cloudy risk of mist patches isolated showers Sunday night.

Mainly good, perhaps moderate to poor at times.
