Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Wednesday will be a cold and very unsettled day for most of the UK with frequent blustery, wintry showers and an early snow risk for many, particularly in the northwest. It will also be a windy day for most parts, especially in the west with gales likely in the southwest.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will be a more settled day than Wednesday with drier conditions and lighter winds, but showers still possible for some areas. Conditions will then turn breezy into Friday with spells of rain, sleet and snow for many parts, especially in central and southern areas. Remaining cold with overnight frosts.
