General Situation

A large complex area of low pressure covering the United Kingdom will maintain the cool unsettled weather. A developing low will run northeastwards up the English Channel through the day, bringing a period of gales or severe gales.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, backing north or northeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 later in east.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing west or southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Squally showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, backing northeast 3 or less, then backing north 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing west, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly backing northeasterly 3 or less, backing northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Squally showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 or 6, backing westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Squally showers.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, backing easterly or northeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Rain for a time in south, then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Squally showers.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough for a time in south.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later near North Foreland.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in west, becoming cyclonic 7 to severe gale 9 for a time, then variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in west.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough at times.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4 at first east of Beachy Head, otherwise 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time, then southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or squally showers at first.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times, backing southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in west, veering northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Isles of Scilly, becoming rough or very rough for a time, except in Lyme bay.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 or 5 east of Lands End, otherwise northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northerly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or squally showers at first.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in Bristol Channel, otherwise south or southwest 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic, then northerly or northeasterly, 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time in west.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Squally showers at first.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, backing northeast, 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 or 6, backing north or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly, backing northerly or northeasterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Squally showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, backing northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight.

Fair, rain later in north.

Good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, backing east, then north or northeast later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4, backing northwest later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, backing north or northeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly, backing northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing northerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in east.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly, backing westerly or northwesterly, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in east.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, backing north or northeast 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter. Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, backing north or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far north, occasionally smooth later in south.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing west, 4 or 5, increasing 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, becoming east or northeast, 4 or 5, backing north or northwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later near Ardnamurchan Point.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing west, 4 or 5, increasing 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will move east or southeast to the south of Shetland and the surrounding waters, as a ridge of high pressure builds from the west.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

East or southeast backing north or northeast 3 or 4.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 04 Nov until 0600 UTC on Monday 05 Nov:

North or northeast backing northwest 3 or 4.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 7 to gale 8 backing southwest by late morning and decreasing 6 to 7, further decreasing 5 to 6 during the evening, veering west 4 to 5 by morning.

Rather rough to rough.

Scattered rain or hail showers, locally heavy with thunder.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 5, becoming cyclonic variable, then northerly 5 to 7 by midday, decreasing 4 to 5 overnight.

Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough overnight.

Scattered rain or hail showers, dying out by evening.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

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
