General Situation

High pressure to the west of Ireland with a ridge extending eastwards, will keep most places fine and quiet, but it will become breezy at times in the far north and in the far south.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly backing westerly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth at times in sheltered east, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time north of Orkney.

Showers, then occasional rain or drizzle.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth at times in sheltered east otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in north.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly backing westerly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Rattray Head, becoming variable 3 at times in south.

Mainly smooth near shore south of Aberdeen, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers in north.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Mainly smooth near shore south of Aberdeen, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north or northwest 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first around headlands.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth at times, mainly near shore.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

North veering northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth in Bristol Channel and near coast of Wales, otherwise slight or moderate.

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate at first in west, otherwise smooth or slight.

Northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Northwesterly backing westerly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in north.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in north.
Occasional drizzle later in north.
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in North Channel.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in North Channel.

Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly backing westerly later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near Mull of Kintyre.
Fair.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly backing westerly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.

Westerly 3 or 4, increasing 5, occasionally 6 at times in north.
Slight or moderate.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly backing westerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.
Smooth at times in central areas, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers, then occasional rain or drizzle.

Slight, perhaps locally moderate at times, mainly in the southwest of the area.

Fine.

Northeast 4 to 5, locally 2 to 3 mid-channel at first, perhaps locally 6 at times in the south.

Slight, occasionally moderate.
