



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment
 Damp surfaces from rain yesterday and clear skies overnight will lead to the formation of some dense patches of fog with visibilities below 100 metres in places. The fog should clear quite quickly by the middle of this morning.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Fog**
 Valid from **03:00 on Sat, 01st Mar 2014** until **09:00 on Sat, 01st Mar 2014**
 Fog patches in Eastern England will become dense in places.
 The public should be aware of disruption to travel due to these areas of poor visibility.
