Forecast for Friday 03 Dec 2021

Weather: A damp start to the night with some drizzle, summit snow flurries, extensive low cloud and hill fog. It will become mainly dry during the early hours, the cloud gradually lifting and then breaking. Daylight hours will bring a mixture of bright or sunny intervals and a few showers, of snow above 700m. Then towards dusk cloud will thicken and lower from the west with some more persistent rain and hill snow developing, heavy at times. Perhaps blizzard conditions on the tops.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 10% in early hours improving to 30% by dawn and 50% during the day, falling 10% in the evening.

Visibility: Poor in early hours due to a combination of cloud as low as 300-600m and some drizzle or light snow, but mainly good during the day away from cloud, which will become occasional above 700-900m and the odd lower patch. Widely poor in the evening in rain and snow and extensive cloud at 450-750m.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

The poorest conditions will be in the early hours and the evening.

Forecast for Saturday 04 Dec 2021

Weather: Mainly cloudy with outbreaks of rain and hill snow, the snow mainly above 500-600m. Some longer drier interludes in the afternoon and evening but any showers that remain, mainly in the north, will turn to snow at all levels

Maximum wind: North or northwest 20 gusts 30mph increasing 30 gusts 40mph in the afternoon. Severe wind chill.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30%, increasing 50%, then 70% in evening

Visibility: Occasionally moderate or poor in rain and snow, very poor in hill fog and blowing snow. Becoming mainly good away from showers later. The cloud 500-700m lifting and breaking more later.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 5 Celsius, falling to Plus 1 in the evening.
At 800m: Minus 1 Celsius falling Minus 3.
Freezing level: 600-700m falling 300m in the evening.
