Forecast for Tuesday 09 Jan 2024

Weather: Light wintry showers dying out overnight then Tuesday will be dry with long periods of sunshine. Feeling bitterly cold with strong easterly winds on the tops. Long clear periods in the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 95%, but 60% in early hours and also in the evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Very good visibility with any cloud above the summits during daytime. Some patchy low cloud and fog above 600m in the early hours, then again in the evening.

Forecast for Wednesday 10 Jan 2024

Weather: Dry with clear spells overnight. Another dry and bright day with long sunny spells. Just the outside chance of a light wintry shower. Still feeling very cold with a severe wind chill.

Maximum wind: East or Northeast 35mph gusts 50mph at first, easing to 25mph gusts 35mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90%.

Low cloud and visibility: Mostly very good. Brief reductions in any wintry showers.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Minus 2C rising to 4C.
At 600m: Minus 2 or 3C.
Freezing level: 200m rising to 600m.
