Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1800 UTC Saturday 01 November to 1800 UTC Sunday 02 November

#### General Situation

A deep area of low pressure will remain slow moving to the south of Iceland whilst a small area of low pressure moves northeastwards past western Scotland tonight, a cold front will sweep southeastwards, introducing cooler, fresher and showery conditions during Sunday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.

Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain for a time then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Occasional rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

Fair then rain or showers.

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate for a time.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair then rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, veering west or southwest 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, veering west or southwest 5 or 6 later.

Rough or very rough becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west or southwest 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.

Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west or southwest 5 or 6 later.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.  
Rain then squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Thundery showers.  
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Slight in Liverpool Bay, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Rain then squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 6 to gale 8, veering west or southwest 5 or 6.  
Moderate or rough, becoming moderate.  
Rain at first.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Mainly moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly veering southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in southeast.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly veering southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in far south.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South veering west or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.  
Moderate or rough.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest, veering west for a time, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.

South or southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Showers.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest, veering west for a time, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.  
Very rough becoming rough.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.

South or southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5.  
Rough.

#### Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A large depression will remain south of Iceland, with a frontal trough moving northeast across Shetland early on Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southwesterly gale force 8.

South 5 to 7, veering southwest later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 02 Nov until 1800 UTC on Sunday 02 Nov:

Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South to southwest 5 to 6, increasing 6 to 7 late evening, locally gale 8 overnight, veering southwest to west and decreasing 4 to 6 Sunday morning.

Moderate to rather rough becoming rather rough to rough for a time overnight.

Rain, locally heavy, by the morning, then scattered showers.

Good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 6, increasing 6 to 7 for a time overnight, decreasing 3 to 4 by afternoon.

Rather rough or rough, becoming slight to moderate in the afternoon.

Rain or showers, heavy at times.

Good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

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
