for the period 1200 UTC Saturday 04 April to 1200 UTC Sunday 05 April 2020

General Situation

A large low in the Atlantic will induce a southerly flow across all parts.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.

Moderate or rough in northwest, smooth or slight in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain, mainly in north.

Good, occasionally poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering southwest, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Rain for a time, otherwise fair.

Good, occasionally moderate for a time.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Mainly fair, but occasional rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering southwest, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time near Rattray Head.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west, veering westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west, veering westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight.
Rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 to 7, veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time.

Rain for a time, then showers.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 to 7, veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time.

Rain for a time, then showers.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Slight or moderate.

South or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time, veering southwest 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain for a time, then showers.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in shelter.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time, veering southwesterly 4 to 6 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.
Rain for a time, then showers.
Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.
Occasional drizzle, mainly in north.
Good, occasionally poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast veering southwest, 6 to gale 8.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.
Rain for a time, then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast veering southwest, 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 for a time.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time.
Rain for a time, then showers.
Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough later.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast veering southwest, 6 to gale 8.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.
Rain for a time, then showers.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A frontal trough will cross from the southwest today, with a strengthening southerly flow becoming established across Shetland waters on Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Cyclonic 4 to 7 becoming southwest 4 to 6, backing south later
Moderate or rough
Rain.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 05 Apr until 1200 UTC on Sunday 05

Apr:
South 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7.
Moderate or rough
Mainly fair.
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 to 4, occasionally 5 by evening, increasing 4 to 6 by midnight, perhaps occasionally 7 mid-channel later.

Slight, increasing moderate in the northwest of the area by dawn tomorrow, locally rather rough mid-channel at times.

Fair or fine.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 to 6, veering southerly by evening, perhaps locally 7 mid-channel for a time, veering southwesterly 3 to 5 on Monday morning.

Slight to moderate, locally rather rough mid-channel at times, decreasing generally slight with a low swell on Monday morning.

Occasional rain arriving in west Sunday evening, clearing east early Monday morning.

Good, perhaps occasionally moderate.
