Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 04 August to 0000 UTC Tuesday 05 August 2014

#### General Situation

An area of low pressure just to the north of Scotland will drift away northwards as a weak ridge of high pressure develops across the United Kingdom. This being followed by a trough of low pressure moving east across the United Kingdom later on Tuesday and during Wednesday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Showers later.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Showers, fair later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest becoming variable, then becoming southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest becoming variable, then becoming southeast, 2 or 3,  
occasionally 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Slight.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north at first, decreasing 3  
or 4, backing southerly later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight.

Showers later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, backing south or southeast later.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Showers at first, then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north at first, becoming variable 3 or 4,  
then becoming southeasterly later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North  
Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 or 4,  
backing southeasterly later.

Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain, then showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.  
Mainly slight.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5, backing southeast later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 3 or 4, occasionally 5, becoming west or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5, backing south later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain then showers, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair then showers.  
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 3 or 4, occasionally 5, becoming west or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5, backing south later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain then showers, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.  
Moderate.  
Fair then showers.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Low centered north of Scotland drifts north, slowly filling, reaching Faroe towards Monday afternoon.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 5 or 6.  
Moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Aug until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Aug:  
Southeast veering west or southwest 5 or 6.  
Moderate.  
Isolated showers.  
Mainly good.

Channel Islands  
24 hour forecast:  
West to southwest 2 to 3, becoming variable 1 to 3 in the afternoon then south during the evening.  
Smooth or slight.  
Risk of a shower.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South 2 to 3, increasing 3 to 4 by morning, backing south to southeast 4 by midnight.  
Slight.  
Isolated showers rain spreading from the west later in the evening, possibly heavy.  
Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain later.

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
