Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Wednesday 01 June to 1200 UTC Thursday 02 June 2022

General Situation

Wednesday afternoon and Wednesday night will see light and variable winds across most of the British inshore waters. Showers will affect many coastlines at times during the afternoon, possibly thundery in the southeast, but they will dissipate during the evening.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less in Moray Firth and in northwest, but elsewhere northwesterly 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate near Orkney and Rattray Head, but elsewhere smooth or slight. Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming east or northeast, 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate to the north and west of Orkney, but elsewhere smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate near Rattray Head and smooth in south.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in Firth of Forth.

Slight in north, smooth or slight in south.

Showers at first in south.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast becoming variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4 becoming southeast 3 to 5, then backing east 2 to 4 later.

Slight.

Showers for a time at first.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

North 2 to 4 becoming variable 2 or less, then southeast 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first in south, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, backing east 2 to 4 later.

Slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then easterly 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 3 to 5, backing northeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Mainly fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or less, then easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery, becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 to 5 backing northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then east or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly backing northeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east, decreasing 2 at times in west.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming northeast 2 to 4, veering east 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first in east, otherwise fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then backing northeast 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then occasionally 4 again later.

Smooth or slight.
Showers at first in east, otherwise fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable, becoming east or northeast later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in west.
Mainly fair.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then occasionally 4 again later.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, becoming northeast 3 to 5 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.
Showers later.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then occasionally 4 again later.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 2 to 4, becoming north or northeast 3 to 5 later.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Fair then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less becoming south or southeast 2 or 3.
Smooth, occasionally slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 2 or 3 backing east or northeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight.
Showers later.
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first, becoming south or southeast 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 at first, backing east 3 to 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first, becoming southerly or southeasterly 2 to 4 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 2 to 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Fair then showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first, becoming south or southeast 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 2 to 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then east or northeast 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less until later in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later in south.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west, becoming variable 2 at times in east.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first in south.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less until later in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight in south, slight throughout in north.

Showers later in south.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in north.

Showers at first in south.

Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 2 to 4, locally variable 1 or 2, veering north or northeast this evening and east or northeast overnight.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of isolated showers in the south on Thursday.

Good, perhaps locally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 on Thursday, locally northerly or northwesterly 1 to 3 in the southeast of the area by midday.

Smooth or slight with a low swell.

Risk of showers.

Good, perhaps locally moderate.

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
