Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Saturday 02 June to 1200 UTC Sunday 03 June 2018

General Situation

Very slack pressure gradients will continue to affect inshore waters of the United Kingdom during the next couple of days. Sea fog will continue to be a risk, especially in the east and further thundery outbreaks are likely in northern and eastern areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly north or northwest 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far north.
Thundery showers for a time near shore, fog patches becoming fog banks.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest veering northeast later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.
Fog banks until later.
Poor or very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming mainly north 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers for a time near shore, fog banks developing.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly north or northwest, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Fog banks until later.
Poor or very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly north later, 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or thundery showers, fog patches becoming fog banks.
Moderate or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain at first, fog banks.
Poor, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or thundery showers, fog banks.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming north 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain at first, fog banks.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or thundery showers, fog patches in south, fog banks in north.

Moderate or very poor, occasionally good in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight becoming smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, mainly in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southwest becoming east later, 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly east or northeast, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

South backing east later, 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate in far west, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers later in west.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East backing northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly south, backing northeast later, 3 or 4.

Smooth in east, otherwise slight becoming mainly moderate.

Showers later in southwest.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands.

Smooth or slight in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable, mainly south, 3 or less.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in far south.
Fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable, mainly northeast later, 3 or less.
Slight or moderate for a time in far south, otherwise smooth or slight.
Fog patches, mainly in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Variable, mainly southwest, 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, occasional rain or thundery showers, mainly in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches at first, thundery showers, mainly in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 2 or 3.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, becoming fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Fair.
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Variable, mainly southerly in east, 3 or less, occasionally 4 in North Channel.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, thundery showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable, mainly southerly, 3 or less, occasionally 4 in North Channel.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northerly 3 or less, occasionally 4 in west.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in west.
Occasional rain or thundery showers, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northerly 3 or less, occasionally 4 in west.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Fog patches, thundery showers near shore.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in far south.
Thundery showers for a time in east, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight, occasionally smooth.
Thundery showers early and late, fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Fog patches, becoming fog banks.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A slack flow covers Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Variable 3 or less

Slight

Mist and fog. Occasionally fair.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 03 Jun until 1200 UTC on Sunday 03 Jun:

Variable, mainly northwest 3 or less, occasionally 4 later

Slight

Mist and fog. Occasionally fair.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, locally north to northeast 3 to 4 jersey southeastwards this afternoon, becoming northeast to east 2 to 4 this evening.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of mist and fog patches in the north of the area early afternoon and perhaps again overnight risk of showers in the west of the area from Sunday morning.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 by mid-afternoon, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight.

Slight, occasionally moderate, with a low swell.

Risk of thundery showers, especially near the french coast.

Good, perhaps occasionally moderate to poor.

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
