General Situation

Unsettled weather will continue to affect the United Kingdom this weekend.
Gales will affect some waters, with severe gales affecting eastern waters of the
English Channel at first.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 6 to gale 8, backing northeast 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7.

Rough occasionally very rough at first.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate or poor becoming good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first near Rattray Head, becoming northeast 5 to
7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate at first in south, otherwise rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Rough or very rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6, decreasing 3 or less later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeast 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, becoming south or southwest 3 to
5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, becoming cyclonic, 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later near Whitby.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later near Whitby.

Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in south, decreasing 3 to 5.

Rough or very rough at first in south, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Rain or showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering westerly 3 to 5.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7, then backing southwesterly 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first in east.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in east, decreasing 3 to 5, then increasing 6 or 7 later.

Very rough or high, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near headlands.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first.

Squally showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West, veering northwest, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate at times in sheltered east, otherwise rough or very rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8.

High, becoming rough or very rough, occasionally moderate later near the Bristol Channel.

Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest, becoming cyclonic, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near St Davids Head, becoming northwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 near St Davids Head.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 near St Davids Head, veering north or northeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Variable 2 to 4, becoming northwest 4 to 6, then becoming cyclonic 3 or 4 later.
Smooth at first in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 3 or 4, becoming northeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in far west.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally poor.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Northeast 3 or less, backing northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest, veering northeast, 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good occasionally moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 2 to 4, increasing 5 for a time in east.
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers, rain at first in south.
Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.
Smooth at first in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming rough later.
Showers, occasional rain in south.
Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, increasing 5 for a time in the North Channel.

Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, becoming northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later in the North Channel.

Smooth at first in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, occasionally 6 near Tiree.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, occasionally 6 near Tiree, becoming northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough in west.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in far north.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north.

Occasional rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Strong to gale force northeasterly winds will continue to affect Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Easterly gale force 8.

Northeast 6 to gale 8.
Rough or very rough.
Mainly fair, but occasional rain in far south.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 03 Nov until 1800 UTC on Sunday 03 Nov:
Northeasterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 in southeast later.
Rough or very rough.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 6 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, backing southwest to south 3 to 5 overnight, perhaps locally variable 1 to 3, becoming northwest 5 to 6 by dawn, backing west 6 to 7 by midday, occasionally gale 8 with gusts to 50kt in the afternoon.
Rough to very rough, gradually decreasing moderate to rather rough overnight, increasing rough to very rough again by midday.
Squally showers or rain, perhaps heavy with a risk of thunder.
Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 6 to 7, perhaps occasionally gale 8 at first, backing southwest 5 to 6 for a time in the evening then southwest to west 5 to 7 in the morning, veering west to northwest by evening.
Rough to very rough, decreasing rather rough to rough for a time late evening and overnight.
Occasional showers or longer periods of rain, locally heavy with the risk of thunder.
Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
