for the period 0000 UTC Saturday 03 June to 0000 UTC Sunday 04 June 2017

#### General Situation

A slow-moving area of low pressure centred to the south of Iceland will bring an unsettled flavour to the weather over the next few days as Atlantic weather systems cross the United Kingdom from west to east.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight or moderate in north, smooth or slight in south.

Fog patches in east, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming mainly south, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate in north, smooth or slight in south.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly southwest 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers for a time.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight.

Showers and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 for a time later.

Slight.

Showers for a time.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming mainly west later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 for a time later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers for a time later.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming westerly or southwesterly later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, thundery at first, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 2 for a time later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly backing southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4, backing southwest 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest backing southwest, 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest backing southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4.

Slight in east, moderate in west.

Fair then showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Moderate in west, slight or moderate in east.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west, becoming variable 2 at times in Bristol Channel.

Slight or moderate.  
Fair then showers.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, increasing 6 at times later.  
Slight at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair then showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 becoming south or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, then becoming south 4 or 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight until later in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming south or southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, then becoming south or southwest 4 or 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight occasionally moderate later.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming south or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southeast, becoming south or southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Moderate or rough near Tiree, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near Tiree.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, veering southwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate in south, slight in north.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate in south, slight in north.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, veering southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate near Sutherland, otherwise moderate or rough.

Fair then showers, thundery for a time later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate near Sutherland, otherwise moderate.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Saturday 03 Jun 2017 at 0000 UTC until Saturday 03 Jun 2017 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A slack pressure pattern will continue to affect the Shetland Waters through Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southwest backing southeast 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate in east, but moderate throughout in north, west and south.

Fog patches, showers later in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 03 Jun until 0000 UTC on Sunday 04 Jun:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in southwest, decreasing 2 at times in north.

Slight or moderate in east, but moderate throughout in north, west and south. Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 2 to 4, backing westerly by midday, occasionally 5 in the north from late afternoon.

Slight.

Some mist or fog patches, clearing by dawn.

Good, locally moderate to very poor at times until morning.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 to 4, backing southwest to south 2 to 4 during the morning.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell.

Risk of a shower.

Mainly good.
