Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

A few gale force gusts around munro tops in the morning.

Forecast for Wednesday 02 Jun 2021

Weather: Another clear night followed by a warm and sunny day, quite windy again on the hills. Perhaps some showers developing later in the afternoon but some uncertainty in the forecast at this stage.

Maximum wind: southeasterly 20-30mph with some stronger gusts at times on the munro summits.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 95%, mainly clear during the day but perhaps some patchy lower cloud later in the day above 700m.

Visibility: Mainly very good but perhaps a slight deterioration later in the day as some showers could develop, please keep checking the forecast for developments on this.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 12 rising to 24 Celsius.
At 800m: Plus 7 rising to 15 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
