General Situation

The complex low over Britain will drift east tonight and through Wednesday. A new developing low and associated frontal system will move in from the west on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5 veering southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later in north.

Moderate or rough.

Showers at first, rain later in west.

Good, occasionally moderate later in west.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near Rattray Head.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far south.
Showers, thundery in west.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming southerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in west.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in south.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 or 6 veering northeast 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate becoming smooth.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southeast 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in north.
Smooth becoming slight or moderate.
Rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Showers at first.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming south or southeast 6 to gale 8.
Smooth or slight becoming rough.
Rain later.
Good, becoming moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in north, veering southeasterly 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4 increasing 6 to gale 8.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.
Rain later.
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 or 6 veering southeasterly 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in west.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough later.

Rain later.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 to 7 veering southeasterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers.

Good.

Southeasterly 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later in west.

Slight or moderate becoming rough, occasionally very rough later in west.

Rain later.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Rough becoming slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in south.

A complex area of low pressure will cover the North Sea on Tuesday with a strong northeast airflow over Shetland. During Wednesday a ridge will build to the NW of your location.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

4 by afternoon.
Slight to moderate, locally rather rough at first.
Isolated showers, especially at first.
Mainly very good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 2 to 3, locally 4 at first, becoming variable then southerly, increasing 4
to 5 Thursday morning, 6 locally 7 in the north of the area during the
afternoon.
Slight or moderate with a swell, locally rather rough, perhaps rough in the
north.
Rain in the west by Thursday afternoon.
Good, locally moderate in rain later.

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
