General Situation

High pressure centred over the southern North Sea will move away southeastwards and decline. Pressure will remain low to the northwest of Scotland.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate in north, slight in southeast.

Occasional rain with fog patches, fair later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate in north, slight in southeast.

Fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, veering southwest then becoming variable later 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southeast for a time, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming mainly south later, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Rain at first.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain, then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate for a time.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 later in south.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain, thundery for a time, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming southwesterly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, thundery rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly veering northwesterly 3 or 4, backing southwesterly 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain, thundery for a time, fog patches, fair later.

Moderate occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering northwest, 3 or 4, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain and fog patches for a time.

Moderate occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 3 or 4, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time in far west.

Fog patches, rain for a time later, becoming fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing west 3 or 4, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, veering northwest 4 or 5 later, then backing west.

Slight or moderate.

Fair, then occasional rain until later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5 occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less until later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Rain and fog patches at first, becoming fair.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fair.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly or southeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later, then veering westerly in north.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Fair, then showers.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later, then veering westerly in north.
Slight or moderate.
Fair, then showers.
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, veering southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Moderate, occasionally rough for a time.
Occasional rain, then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5, veering west later.
Moderate occasionally rough later.
Showers.
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly 4 or 5 decreasing 3 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 decreasing 3 at times, backing southeasterly later in north.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in west, backing southeasterly later in north.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Moderate southeasterly winds will become light and variable later.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then occasional rain with fog patches.

Good, becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Friday 02 Jun until 1800 UTC on Friday 02 Jun:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain with fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, locally 4, becoming westerly by Friday morning, increasing 3 to 4 in the afternoon.

Smooth or slight.

Mist or fog patches developing in the west overnight, becoming more extensive by midday with patchy rain, all clearing early evening.

Moderate to good locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 to 4, veering northwest for a time overnight.

Slight locally moderate, with a swell.

Risk of a shower on shower.
