Forecast for Monday 02 Aug 2021

Weather: The majority will stay dry on a rather cloudy start to the week, with the best of the limited brighter spells expected across southwestern peaks such as Ben Lawers during the afternoon. Some risk of the odd light afternoon shower developing.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 70%

Visibility: Generally very good, but very poor in cloud with bases lowering 600-900m at times, chiefly during the morning and across the north and east.

Forecast for Tuesday 03 Aug 2021

Weather: Morning sunny spells bubbling up some scattered afternoon showers, on an otherwise dry day.

Maximum wind: South to southwest around 10mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 95% becoming 80% during the afternoon.

Visibility: Generally very good, but very poor where cloud bases lower to 700-1000m, mainly in the afternoon and in the showers.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 6 Celsius increasing 20 Celsius during the afternoon
At 800m: Plus 9 Celsius increasing 15 Celsius during the afternoon
Freezing level: Above all summits
