Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 03 February to 1200 UTC Tuesday 04 February 2014

#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will remain west of Scotland, with a cold front moving east across the United Kingdom, clearing the east early on Tuesday. A vigorous Atlantic depression will approach southwestern areas later on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time in east.

Fair then rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in east.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 until later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north.

Rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, backing southeast 6 to gale 8.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Mainly fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south later, 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Rain or showers for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, backing southeast 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later near Whitby.

Occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, veering southerly or southwesterly later, 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 or 6, backing southeasterly 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, veering southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally rough in west at first.

Fair then rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, veering west or southwest 5 to 7, backing south later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain for a time, then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering west or southwest 5 to 7, backing south later.

Rough or very rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, increasing gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest later.

Rough or very rough, becoming high or very high.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, veering west or southwest 5 or 6, then backing south 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, increasing gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest later.

Rough or very rough, becoming high or very high.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering west or southwest 4 or 5, then backing south or southwest 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain at first then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, increasing gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high, occasionally very high later near St Davids Head.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 7 or gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Rough, occasionally very rough at first near the Mull of Galloway, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north and west later.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 7 or gale 8, veering south or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, backing southeast 7 or gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9.

Moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate.

Rain at first then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, backing southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, veering southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly, backing southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate becoming rough, occasionally very rough later in the North Channel.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering south 5 or 6.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate for a time in east.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, backing east or southeast 7 to severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough.

Showers, rain later.

Good becoming moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, but very rough at first in south.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 to 7, backing east 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far south.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 to 7, backing east 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 03 Feb 2014 at 1200 UTC until Tuesday 04 Feb 2014 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A strong southeasterly flow covers Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southeasterly gale force 8.

Southeast 7 or gale 8.  
Rough or very rough.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 04 Feb until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 04 Feb:  
Southeast 6 to gale 8.  
Rough or very rough.  
Mainly fair, occasional rain or showers later.  
Mainly good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to 7, locally 8 in the north at first, veering southwest to west 4 to 5 this evening, backing southwest to south 5 to 6 by dawn and south to southeast by midday.

Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough overnight.

Rain spreading from the west this afternoon, clearing this evening, then scattered rain or hail showers.

Moderate to good, locally poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to south 5 to 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9 with gusts to 60kt by evening, veering southwest overnight.

Rather rough with swell, increasing very rough to high overnight.

Rain by evening, clearing overnight then scattered rain or hail showers.

Moderate to good, locally moderate to poor at times.

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
