Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Tuesday 04 June to 0000 UTC Wednesday 05 June 2019

General Situation

A large low to the north of Scotland will slowly move away to the north during Tuesday, with another low crossing from the southwest, bringing strong winds at times and some rain or thundery showers in many areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough, mainly in north.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in north.

Moderate to the north and east of Orkney, otherwise slight.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, backing east or southeast, then backing northeast later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 5 or 6, then veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time later.

Fair then occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, backing southeasterly for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time later.

Mainly fair, then occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, backing southeasterly, then veering southwesterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight.

Mainly fair, then occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight.

Showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5 for a time, then veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Fair then rain or showers, occasionally thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South, veering west or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then rain or showers, occasionally thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South, veering west or southwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then rain or showers, occasionally thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, veering southwest later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest, veering northwest, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, backing east for a time, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, veering northwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, backing southeast, then backing northeast later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic then west or northwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic, then northeasterly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly backing northwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic, then northeasterly later, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly backing northwesterly, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Mull of Kintyre.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeast 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 to 7, backing northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northerly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northerly 4 or 5.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A deep low centred near the Faeroes will fill north during Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:
Southwesterly gale force 8 at time of issue.

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in northwest
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in northwest
Showers
Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun until 0000 UTC on Wednesday
05 Jun:
Southwesterly 5 or 6 becoming variable 3 or 4
Moderate or rough, becoming slight east of Shetland
Showers dying out
Mainly good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable or southerly 1 to 3, locally 4, becoming mainly southeasterly 2 to 4
around dawn, perhaps locally 5, veering southwest to west and increasing 4 to 5
late afternoon, locally 6 until late evening.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight to moderate in the evening.

Showers from dawn then a longer periods of rain from mid morning, locally heavy
with a risk of thunder, clearing early afternoon.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest to west 4 to 5, locally 3 near the brittany coast, decreasing 2 to 4
in the morning, veering west to northwest by midday.

Slight, perhaps moderate in the west of the area at first, with a low swell.

Isolated showers mainly in the morning.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

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
