#### General Situation

A cooler west to northwesterly airflow will prevail across the British Isles during the next 24 hours.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time.

Rough for a time to the west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate. Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough to the west and north of Orkney at first. Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Mainly west or northwest 4 to 6, but variable 2 or 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Firth of Forth.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, mainly in north.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, but westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, becoming fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, but westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, but westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight, becoming moderate later in north.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:  
West 4 or 5, backing north overnight, then becoming variable with sea breezes 4 or less Tuesday afternoon.  
Mostly smooth, but with a slight Atlantic swell west of Start Point.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable , becoming mainly northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally smooth in east.  
Fair.  
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:  
Northwest 3 to 5, backing north 2 to 4, occasionally 5 on Tuesday afternoon.  
Mostly slight, but smooth in Bristol Channel.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable , becoming mainly northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable, mainly north, 2 to 4.  
Generally smooth, but with a slight Atlantic swell, mainly Cornwall and  
pembrokeshire coasts.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable, mainly north, 4 or less.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.  
Mainly slight, but moderate for a time south of morecambe.  
Showers at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 3 to 5.  
Slight.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West or northwest 4 to 6, occasionally 3 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 3 to 5.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.  
Moderate or rough at first in northwest, otherwise slight.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 3 to 5.  
Slight in east, moderate in northwest.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North  
Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Mull of Kintyre at first.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight throughout in Firth of Clyde, but elsewhere slight or moderate.  
Mainly fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers then occasional rain, but fair for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 to 5, perhaps 2 for a time this evening.

Mostly slight, but moderate swell for a time in far north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers then occasional rain, but fair for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 to 6 , decreasing 2 or 3 for a time this evening.

Rough becoming moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first near Cape Wrath.

Moderate.

Showers then occasional rain, but fair for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

An occasionally strong northwesterly airstream covers Shetland waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later

Moderate or rough, but slight in sheltered eastern waters

Showers

Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul:

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 3 to 4, soon veering north to northeast, then increasing 5 at times after dawn tomorrow in southeast, perhaps 6 for a time in the far southeast, then decreasing 2 by late afternoon in the far north.  
Smooth to slight, perhaps locally moderate later in far southeast.  
Fair or fine.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northeast, 2 at first in far north, otherwise 3 to 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair or fine.
