



National Severe Weather Warning Service

Chief Forecasters Assessment

An occluded front will be slow moving across Northern Ireland on Monday night and Tuesday morning, bringing bands of showers and longer spells of heavy rain. The front will move south on Tuesday morning with rain clearing.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **18:00 on Mon, 08th Feb 2016** until **10:00 on Tue, 09th Feb 2016**

Heavy rain or showers will affect the north and west of Northern Ireland on Monday evening and overnight before clearing on Tuesday morning. Rainfall accumulations of 20-30mm are possible in places.

The public should be aware that there is the potential for some localised flooding.
