Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 03 June to 1200 UTC Monday 04 June 2018

General Situation

A slack, mainly northeasterly airflow will affect inshore waters of the United Kingdom during the next couple of days. A cold front moving erratically southwestwards in the flow will bring clearer and fresher air with it, eventually clearing the sea fog away from northern and eastern areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwest veering northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in north.

Fog banks, becoming fair later.

Moderate to very poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later towards Rattray Head.

Fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly north 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain at first in south, fog patches, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate, then moderate or rough later towards Rattray Head.

Fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or showers at first, fog banks.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fog banks, becoming fair later.
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fog banks, becoming fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in east.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Smooth or slight at times in west, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 offshore.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 offshore.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate offshore.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate in west and near prawle point, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands.

Slight or moderate in west and near prawle point, otherwise smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first in west, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, becoming variable at times in east, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands in south.

Smooth or slight in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight in east, otherwise slight or moderate.
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming mainly north 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate in far south, otherwise smooth or slight.
Fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in north.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in north.
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming northeast later, 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Fair.
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly north later, 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Showers at first.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly north, veering east, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in southeast.
Thundery showers with fog patches, becoming fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northerly later, 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northerly, veering easterly, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers with fog patches, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northerly or northeasterly 3 or less, occasionally 4 in west.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.

Rain or thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly northerly, becoming southeasterly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers at first near shore.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally smooth, but moderate at times in far south and also later in far north.

Thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering east later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches, fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering east later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate.

Fair.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 03 Jun 2018 at 1200 UTC until Monday 04 Jun 2018 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will cover Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

West or northwest 3 or 4

Slight

Mainly fair, occasional sea fog patches in south

Good, occasionally very poor in south

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 04 Jun until 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Jun:

West or northwest 3 or 4 veering north or northeast 4 or 5

Slight or moderate.

Fair, isolated sea fog patches in far south at first

Good, occasionally very poor in south at first

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 3 to 4, occasionally 5, increasing 4 to 5 by late afternoon, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 to 4 for a time overnight.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Isolated thundery showers, especially near the french coast, perhaps drifting over the channel by midday on Monday mist or fog patches mainly in the north of the area by early Monday morning.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 5, occasionally 6.

Slight to moderate, with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches at times mainly in the north of the area, scattered thundery showers mainly in the south.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor and locally very poor.

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
