General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will move east into the United Kingdom during Monday to be followed by a weakening trough of low pressure moving southeast during Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 3 or 4, backing southerly 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north and west.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west or southwest 4 or 5.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A ridge of high pressure will build over Shetland on Monday while a weak frontal
trough moves east over the area.

Northwest backing west or southwest 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Aug until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 03 Aug:

West or southwest 3 or 4 backing south 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in the west.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North to northwest 2 or 3, locally west to southwest in the south at first, backing northwest 3 or 4 in the afternoon.

Slight.

Rain and drizzle at first in the southeast, soon clearing then fair.

Good, locally moderate to poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 2 to 4 backing west to southwest 3 or 4 later Tuesday, perhaps 5 in the northwest on Wednesday morning.

Slight, locally moderate in the north later.

Fair becoming cloudy by afternoon, with outbreaks of rain or drizzle overnight, with a risk of fog patches.

Good becoming locally moderate to very poor later.

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
