Forecast for Thursday 07 Sep 2023

Weather: Dry in the early hours with some fog patches developing in the glens. Then a mainly dry day but there will be a fair amount of high cloud around at times. Small chance of a few passing showers or thunderstorm across the far west first thing in the morning, and more widely in the afternoon and evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 90%

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility on the summits with cloud above the tops. Some haziness in the air.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Be prepared for sunburn in any prolonged sunshine, as well as dehydration.

Forecast for Friday 08 Sep 2023

Weather: Overnight fog patches soon clearing away to leave a dry day with some bright or sunny spells, some high cloud around at times. Feeling very warm or hot. Brisk winds on the tops.

Maximum wind: Southwesterly 20 to 30 mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 90%

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility with cloud above the summits but some haziness in the air

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 16 rising to 27 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 19 Celsius by afternoon
Freezing level: Above the summits
