for the period 1200 UTC Tuesday 02 August to 1200 UTC Wednesday 03 August 2011

#### General Situation

The British Isles will remain under a slack airflow with generally light winds bringing the threat of fog in places and some areas will see heavy showers too.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, increasing 4 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Orkney.

Rain or thundery showers, fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming east or southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fog banks in east.

Moderate or good, but very poor in east.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming southeast 3 or 4.

Fog banks in north, rain later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor in north.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Slight, becoming moderate west of the Lizard peninsula.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor east of Start Point.

Mainly south or southwest, veering west later 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Variable becoming mainly southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in west.  
Slight.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Mainly south or southwest, veering west later 4 or 5.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Mainly fair.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in North Channel.

Smooth or slight, , occasionally moderate near the Mull of Kintyre.

Rain or showers later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Complex shallow low will be slow moving near the UK with series of fronts extending across Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeasterly 4 or 5 but southerly or southwesterly 3 at first in the west.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers, perhaps thundery, with fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Aug until 1200 UTC on  
Wednesday 03 Aug:  
Southeast 4, occasionally 3 later.  
Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, with mist and fog patches increasing.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 2 to 4 becoming variable 1 or 2 overnight then west 3 to 4 tomorrow morning.

Slight.

Risk of a thundery shower.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 to 4, backing southwest to south later Wednesday.

Mainly slight.

Rain or drizzle from early Thursday with a risk of fog patches.

Good becoming moderate to poor.

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
