for the period 0000 UTC Saturday 05 October to 0000 UTC Sunday 06 October 2019

General Situation

An Atlantic frontal system will move in to affect the British Isles over the weekend, while high pressure becomes slow-moving over Scandinavia.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5, veering southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later near Orkney.

Slight at first in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near Orkney.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 3 to 5, veering southeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later near Rattray Head.

Moderate, becoming rough in far north.

Showers in north, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 near Rattray Head.

Moderate, but rough at times in north.

Rain at times, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 2 or 3, veering southeast 3 or 4, then increasing 5 or 6 later.

Moderate.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6, backing east 4 or 5 later.

Moderate.

Rain at times, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast veering southeast 2 to 4, then increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, backing east 4 or 5 later.

Moderate.

Rain at times, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northerly veering easterly 3 or 4 , then veering southeasterly 4 or 5 later.
Slight, becoming moderate later in north.
Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, then easterly 5 or 6 later.
Slight at first in south, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough later in east.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly veering easterly 3 or 4, then becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming westerly 5 or 6, then veering northerly or
northwesterly 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 1 to 3, then southwest 3 to 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, veering west 5 or 6, then veering northwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain at first, then showers, fair later.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, backing south 2 to 4, then veering southwest 4 to 6 later.
Slight or moderate in east, but moderate or rough in west.
Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing west 3 or 4
later.
Slight or moderate, but moderate or rough in far west.
Rain at first, then showers, fair later.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming south or southwest 4 to 6 later.
Slight or moderate in east, but moderate or rough in west.
Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing west 3 or 4
later.
Slight or moderate in east, but moderate or rough in west.

Rain at first, then showers, fair later.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Variable 2 to 4, becoming south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.
Moderate, becoming slight later in north.
Rain at first, then showers, fair later.
Moderate, becoming good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly veering southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.
Slight or moderate.
Fair at first, then rain at times.
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeasterly 4 to 6, veering northwesterly 4 or 5, then veering southeasterly 4 to 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain at first, then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East 4 or 5, veering southeast 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate.
Fair at first, then rain at times.
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 5 or 6, veering northwest 4 or 5, then veering southeast 5 or 6 later.
Moderate, becoming slight later.
Rain at first, then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East 4 or 5, veering southeast 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Fair at first, then rain at times.
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic becoming northwest 4 or 5, then veering southeast 4 to 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain at first, then showers.
Moderate becoming good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East 4 or 5, veering southeast 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Fair at first, then rain at times.
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming northwest 4 or 5, then veering southeast 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, but slight or moderate in shelter.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then south 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough, but slight or moderate in shelter.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 to 6, veering southeasterly 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 or 3 for a time in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Rain at times, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming southeast 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain at times, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Saturday 05 Oct 2019 at 0000 UTC until Saturday 05 Oct 2019 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure extending southeast across Shetland water declines north as a low pushes east across central UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:

Southerly gale force 8 expected later, issued at 15:45 UTC on Friday 4th October.

Southeasterly 3 to 5, but 6 in southwest.

Moderate, rough in the west.

Mainly fair
Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 05 Oct until 0000 UTC on Sunday 06 Oct:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, but 3 or 4 at first in northeast, perhaps gale 8 later in southwest.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in west.

Fair.

Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 5 to 6, perhaps locally 7 at first, decreasing 4 to 5 by morning, backing west 2 to 4 early afternoon, then southwest to south in the evening, increasing 4 to 5 by midnight.

Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough by morning, then mainly slight by midday, locally moderate later.

Scattered showers rain, locally heavy, spreading from the west in the evening, with a slight risk of thunder later.

Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 4 to 6, veering northwest 5 to 6 around dawn, perhaps locally 7, decreasing 4 to 5 by evening and 3 to 4 later.

Slight to moderate becoming moderate to rather rough by Sunday morning, locally rough, decreasing slight to moderate with a swell later.

Rain, locally heavy with the slight risk of thunder, clearing by morning.

Moderate to poor, becoming good by morning.
