Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Sunday 04 June to 0600 UTC Monday 05 June 2017

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure extending across the United Kingdom from the south will decline later today and during Monday. A deep area of low pressure will northeastwards across Scotland on Monday with another area of low pressure moving across England and Wales later on Monday and during Tuesday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight in southeast, slight or moderate in north.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, becoming east or northeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in southeast.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, backing south 4 or 5, backing southeast 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6, veering south 4 or 5, veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, occasionally 6 later in north.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly backing southeasterly later, 5 or 6, then veering northwesterly 5 to 7.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5 increasing 6 at times, veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers, then occasional rain.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in south.  
Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly then veering westerly later, 5 or 6 occasionally 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in east.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly then veering westerly later, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly backing southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 6 to gale 8, veering northwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in west.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, then rain until later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor until later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers for a time, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 or 7, backing south 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers for a time, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, becoming west 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic then northwest later, 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest backing south 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers at first, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west or southwest, 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, then veering north or northwest 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain for a time later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 5 to 7, becoming west 4 or 5, veering northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain for a time later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 5 to 7, becoming westerly 4 or 5, veering northwesterly 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast later, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 for a time, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 5 to 7, becoming northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5 decreasing 3 at times, then backing northeasterly occasionally 6 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly becoming cyclonic 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5 decreasing 3 at times, then backing northeasterly occasionally 6 in south.

Moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly becoming cyclonic 5 or 6.

Moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Light winds throughout.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Variable mainly east or south, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times  
Slight or moderate  
Showers for a time.  
Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 04 Jun until 0600 UTC on Monday 05 Jun:  
Variable mainly east of southeast, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair.  
Good

#### Channel Islands

##### 24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3 jersey southwards by mid afternoon, then southwest to south 4 to 5 overnight.  
Smooth or slight, increasing slight, occasionally moderate overnight.  
Isolated showers by noon, dying out overnight.  
Good or very good, locally moderate in showers.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 4 to 5, increasing 5 to 7 in the afternoon, with gusts to 40kt, veering west to northwest in the evening, locally gale 8 with gusts to 50kt, decreasing 5 to 6 by morning.

Slight to moderate, with a low swell, increasing rather rough to rough in the afternoon.

Outbreaks of rain from the west, perhaps heavy with a risk of thunder, clearing to isolated showers overnight.

Good becoming moderate to poor in rain.

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
