Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

#### General Situation

An area of low pressure drifts slowly eastwards to be over Ireland on Sunday night. Fronts and troughs will move eastwards across the United Kingdom during the next few days.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

General Situation

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers and fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 04 Jul until 0000 UTC on Sunday 05 Jul:  
In north, northeasterly 4 or 5, in south, northeasterly 3 becoming variable 3 or less.
