Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

High pressure across the northern North Sea will drift east into Scandinavia during Tuesday, while pressure remains low to the south and southeast of the United Kingdom.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Fog patches in Moray Firth, otherwise fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in Moray Firth.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly east or northeast, 3 or 4.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or poor.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 3 or 4 backing northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in south.

Occasional drizzle with fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly backing northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in east.

Occasional drizzle, with fog patches in east.

Moderate, occasionally very poor in east.

Slight or moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, backing north later.

Occasional drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5, backing north 3 or 4 later.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
East 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, backing north later.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.  
Mainly slight.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.  
Mainly slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Occasional drizzle.  
Moderate or good.  
Mainly slight.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 2 later.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
East 3 or 4, occasionally variable later.  
Occasional drizzle.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.  
Slight in south, moderate in north.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde  
and the North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.  
Mainly slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 3 or 4.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly veering southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west,  
becoming variable later.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 3 or 4.  
Fair.  
Good.
