General Situation

A large area of high pressure continues to be centred across the United Kingdom, with light winds across most areas, but occasional strong winds in the extreme northwest and southeast.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Deep low around Iceland moving northeast through the Norwegian Sea on Wednesday with associated weather front pushing east through Shetland. Ridge of high pressure then building on Thursday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southeast severe gale force 9 at time of issue.

South or southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in north and west,

veering west 5 or 6, becoming 4 in south.
Rough or very rough, occasionally high in west.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Wednesday 02 Mar until 0600 UTC on
Thursday 03 Mar:

West or northwest 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, occasionally 2 in south.
