Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Glen temperatures closer to minus 6 in places around dawn. Note 'feels like' temperatures in negative double digits.

Forecast for Saturday 06 Mar 2021

Weather: Another cold start with a frost for most parts, then a dry day with plenty of sunshine through morning. A cloudier afternoon looks likely, although remaining dry and most cloud above the summits. Dry, occasionally clear through evening.

Maximum wind: West or southwest 10-20mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90% with very little, if any low level cloud.

Visibility: Very good.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 1 or 2C rising 5 or 6C.
At 800m: Minus 2 or 3C.
Freezing level: 200m rising 500m.
