

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 03 Jan 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry and very cold for most, with a widespread frost at first. The cloud initially across central UK will slowly disperse, with most places becoming increasingly sunny. However the far north will remain cloudier throughout today and overnight, with occasional light rain and drizzle for the Northern Isles. Elsewhere overnight clear, leading to a widespread moderate to locally severe frost.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday patchy light rain or drizzle becoming more widespread across Scotland, then extending south across northern and eastern England. Risk of icy conditions as rain falls onto frozen surfaces. Monday cold and clearer conditions spreading across most of the UK.
