Forecast for Monday 05 Jun 2023

Weather: Low cloud will affect the north and east of the region through the early hours, perhaps giving the odd spot of drizzle, with clear skies in the west. The low cloud in the east will slowly clear through the morning to leave mostly sunny conditions into the afternoon, with some patchy high cloud possible. Low cloud making a return late evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 70-80% in the west, 30% in the east, improving to 90% across the region by midday. 60% in the east late evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Low cloud, base 400-600m, in the east at first, slowly clearing. Low cloud, base 600-800m, in the east late evening. Visibility good or very good out with cloud.

Forecast for Tuesday 06 Jun 2023

Weather: Low cloud again to start the day for all but the far west but this burning off by around midday to leave plenty of sunny spells. Perhaps a little low cloud in the east again late evening but this less widespread than Monday.

Maximum wind: East to northeast 10 mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 40% at first but 70% in the far west, improving to 90% into the afternoon. 70% in the east late evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Low cloud, base 500-700m, at first, lifting then clearing through the morning. Scattered low cloud, base 600-800m, in east late evening. Visibility good or very good away from cloud.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 9 rising to plus 18 Celsius.
At 800m: Plus 6 rising to plus 13 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above summits.
